


Karen L. is back with another amazing **art project** that you'll love. Create **decoupage boxes** to hold your treasures and remember this program forever!




Just in time for Mother's Day: a make-andtake **horticulture craft** that's lovely. You'll be decorating a container for a **silver lace fern**—what a great gift!




## It's a Fundraiser!

# Reading Glasses Available




It can be frustrating to be in a building full of reading material and not be able to see clearly.
